



# Risk Reduction Guidelines for Makeup Artists

from the Makeup Artist Sanitation Standard

## WEAR A MASK

At all times! Goggles or face shields must also be worn while working.

## SOCIALLY DISTANCE

Only talent and artist are allowed within 6 feet of the makeup area.

## SANITIZE SURFACES

Wipe down makeup station, chair, tools and products prior to use. Sanitize products often while working.

## WASH HANDS

Use soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds before work, between tasks and at end of day.

## NO DOUBLE DIPPING

Create "working stock" you can work from or a "ghost" to work from for pressed items.

## BRUSHES AND TOOLS

Separate sets should be used for each talent. Disposables for lips and eyes MUST be used to avoid contamination.

## PROPERLY DISPOSE OF PPE

Remove PPE at end of day and either throw away or put in plastic bag to wash at home.

## DISINFECT TOOLS

Wipe down contaminated areas after working. Disinfect tools properly and allow to air dry completely.
